9	Living World	Revision for mini tests Research: causes, effects and solutions to deforestation Project based task: case study of a biome- location, features, adaptations, threats, sustainable use
10	Changing Economic World	Revision for mock examination (20 th May) using revision guide and exercise books Improvement questions based on Y10 examination Skills practise sheets with accompanying homework book Changing Economic World Knowledge organisers (creation of personal A3 revision sheets)
11	Revision: P1- Physical Geography: Natural Hazards, Living World, Physical Geography of the UK P2- Human Geography: Urban Issues and Challenges, Changing Economic World, Resource Management	Students have a 'Question a day' calendar A3 sheet, which should be used in conjunction with revision guides and exercise books.
